

Southeast Area Transit District (SEAT) provided transit service in Southeast Connecticut. SEAT is a transit district is formed under State Statue and has a population of 274,150 in a service area of 325 square miles. SEAT operates a bus only system of 18 peak vehicles. SEAT does not receive FTA operating assistance and does not use FTA funding for preventive maintenance or ADA. SEAT has the following FTA funding projects currently in progress.
